



Houston Mayor Told People There Was No Need to Evacuate for Hurricane Harvey

Despite Texas Governor Abbott declaring a state of disaster from the effects of Hurricane Harvey last Wednesday, the mayor of Houston, Sylvester Turner, advised citizens to stay where they were. Many areas were more than 20 feet underwater, and rescue operations were required, particularly for senior citizens. A Houston resident, Rebecca Reisig, posted a Facebook comment that the Houston City Council knew Hurricane Harvey was expected to do greater damage than was being reported to the public, and her report went viral. In response, Harris County Judge Ed Emmett advised worried citizens that the Facebook rumor was false and that people should get their news from official sources, a line that was parroted by Mayor Turner. Facebook removed Reisig's account.

A Houston-area woman set off a firestorm in the hours leading up to Hurricane Harvey's landfall when she wrote on social media that local officials and the mainstream media were misleading the public about the severity of the incoming storm.

Resident [Rebecca Reisig](#) said the Houston City Council knew Hurricane Harvey was expected to do far greater damage than was being reported to the public.

President Trump Pardoned Controversial Arizona Sheriff Joe Arpaio

Arizona Sheriff, Joe Arpaio, was pardoned by President Trump on his conviction for criminal contempt after he defied a court order and refused to cease traffic stops of vehicles suspected of carrying illegal immigrants.

Arpaio became controversial for constructing outdoor tent cities for prisoners, reviving chain gangs, serving bad food, and making the inmates wear prison stripe clothes and pink underwear to humiliate them. The intent of all that was to

discourage crime and to stop illegal immigrants from entering his county. He says he was prosecuted by Obama holdovers because he conducted an investigation into Obama's birth certificate and declared it a fake. Arpaio endorsed Trump before he was taken seriously as a candidate.

The big rumor – emphasis on the word “rumor” – ahead of [President Donald Trump's trip to Phoenix for a campaign rally tonight](#) is that he might issue a pardon for Joe Arpaio, the controversial former sheriff of Maricopa County.

“I am seriously considering a pardon for Sheriff Arpaio,” [Trump told “Fox News Sunday” earlier this month](#). “He has done a lot in the fight against illegal immigration. He's a great American patriot, and I hate to see what has happened to him.” [Trump later retweeted the article](#) about his comments.

And/but: [CNN reported Monday that the Department of Justice had not been consulted on the potential pardon](#).

The “will he/won't he” speculation will run all day – right up until Trump takes the stage in Phoenix around 10 p.m. eastern tonight. So, it's worth asking: How did we get here with Joe Arpaio?

Arpaio first came to national prominence in the early 1990s when, as newly elected sheriff of Maricopa County, he pushed the construction of Tent City – an open-air jail he viewed as not only a solution to prison overcrowding but also a way to burnish his tough-on-crime persona.

“We're going to do it, and it's time to get tough around here,” Arpaio said in 1993 when Tent City was unveiled, [according to the Arizona Republic](#). “And to get tough, you have to have a place to put the bad guys.”

Arpaio also made prisoners wear pink underwear and pink handcuffs as a way of shaming them (and to stop them from stealing each others' clothes). In the mid-1990s, he reinstated chain gangs – including for women and juveniles. He pushed for every mug shot to be posted online. He cut down prison meals to two a day – no lunch! – and banned the use of salt and pepper to save money.

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Jacob Rothschild Recently Cut His Holdings in US Investments

According to his bi-annual financial report, Jacob Rothschild

Jacob Rothschild has aggressively minimized his exposure to what he views as a risky U.S. capital market. Rothschild is the founder and chairman of Rit Capital Partners. In the half-year financial report for Rit Capital Partners, Rothschild explained the companies [significant exposure reduction](#) to U.S. assets.

Rothschild stated, "We do not believe this is an appropriate time to add to risk. Share prices have in many cases risen to unprecedented levels at a time when economic growth is by no means assured. "

Rothschild also gave his opinion that he believes quantitative easing programs employed by central banks, such as the Federal Reserve Bank in the U.S. will no longer be implemented. Rothschild was quoted in the written report as saying, "The period of monetary accommodation may well be coming to an end."

The British investment banking veteran has significantly reduced the amounts of investment Rit Capital Partners has in the U.S. dollar. On December 31, 2016, Rit Capital Partners reported a 62 percent net value asset investment in U.S. dollars. In the latest report released by Rit Capital Partners on June 30, 2017, the company has a 37 percent net value asset investment in U.S. dollars.

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Trump's Economic Advisor Gary Cohn Described Antifa As Citizens Standing for Freedom

President Trump's National Economic Council Director Gary Cohn said in a recent interview that members of Antifa are just concerned citizens 'standing up for equality and freedom'. He criticized Trump for blaming both sides for violence in the streets and said the administration must do better to condemn pro-white groups. National Economic Council Director Gary Cohn claimed that militant "anti-fascists" (or "antifa") are just concerned citizens "standing up for equality and freedom" in a Financial Times [interview](#) that ran Friday.

"Citizens standing up for equality and freedom can never be equated with white supremacists, neo-Nazis, and the KKK," Cohn said of the recent violence at a white nationalist rally in Charlottesville. "I believe this administration can and must do better in consistently and unequivocally condemning these groups and do everything we can to heal the deep divisions that exist in our communities."

Cohn's comments were a clear shot at President Trump, who took heat in the media for [acknowledging](#) that "both sides" engaged

in the violence in Charlottesville.

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Christian Ministry Sues SPLC for Hate Map Listing

D. James Kennedy Ministries (DJKM) is suing the Southern Poverty Law Center for listing DJKM in its infamous ‘hate map’. The lawsuit includes Amazon and Guidestar, who dropped DJKM from their services because of the listing. –GEG

A Christian TV ministry announced Wednesday that it is suing the Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC) for labeling it a hate group, like the Ku Klux Klan.

Dr. Frank Wright, president of D. James Kennedy Ministries (DJKM), said he was suing the SPLC for listing DJKM in the infamous “hate map,” according to [Christian Today](#). The SPLC’s hate map lists DLKM, as well as several other Christian and conservative advocacy groups, alongside the KKK and neo-Nazis. Kennedy claimed that the SPLC “illegally trafficked in false and misleading descriptions” of DJKM. ([RELATED: 5 Groups Included On ‘Hate Group’ List Published By CNN Are Not Hate Groups](#))

“We embarked today on a journey to right a terrible wrong,” Kennedy said in the announcement of the lawsuit. “Those who knowingly label Christian ministries as ‘hate’ groups, solely for subscribing to the historic Christian faith, are either woefully uninformed or willfully deceitful. In the case of the Southern Poverty Law Center, our lawsuit alleges the latter.”

A domestic terrorist actually used the hate map in 2012 as the [inspiration for an attack](#) against the Family Research Council. The FBI ceased using the group’s list as a legitimate source after the attack.

“These false and illegal characterizations have a chilling effect on the free exercise of religion and on religious free speech for all people of faith,” Kennedy said. “After having given the SPLC an opportunity to retract, we have undertaken this legal action, seeking a trial by a jury of our peers, to preserve our own rights under the law and to defend the religious free speech rights of all Americans.”

Kennedy said the lawsuit included Amazon and Guidestar, who allegedly dropped DJKM from their services, which included the AmazonSmile Foundation’s charitable list, because of the ministry’s listing on the hate map. Kennedy claimed that DJKM’s removal from Amazon’s charitable list limited the methods by which the ministry could receive donations.

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Apple Asks Users to Fund Alt-Left SPLC Group that Targets Conservatives

Apple iTunes users are being asked to fund the alt-left Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC) to 'fight hate' even though the SPLC already has \$320 million in assets. In the wake of Charlottesville, Apple CEO Tim Cook donated \$1 million to the SPLC as well as another \$1 million to the Anti-Defamation League, and he says he will match employee donations. The SPLC labels traditional Christian groups as hate groups because they don't go along with LGBTBBQ-progressivism. JP Morgan is also donating \$1 million to the SPLC and ADL. Fox's James Murdoch, one of two Trump-hating sons of Rupert Murdoch, has also donated \$1 million to the ADL. -GEG
