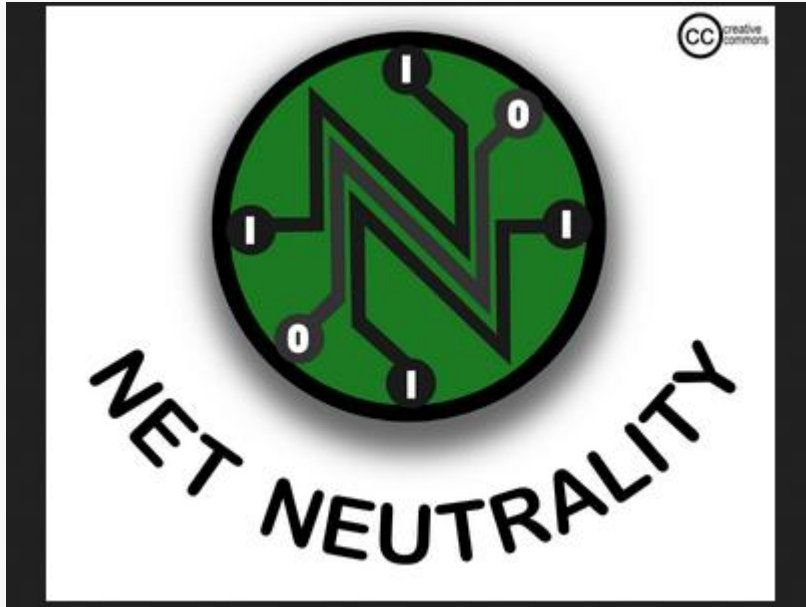


The "Ugly" Truth About Net Neutrality: Google and Facebook Will Be Exempt from Regulations
