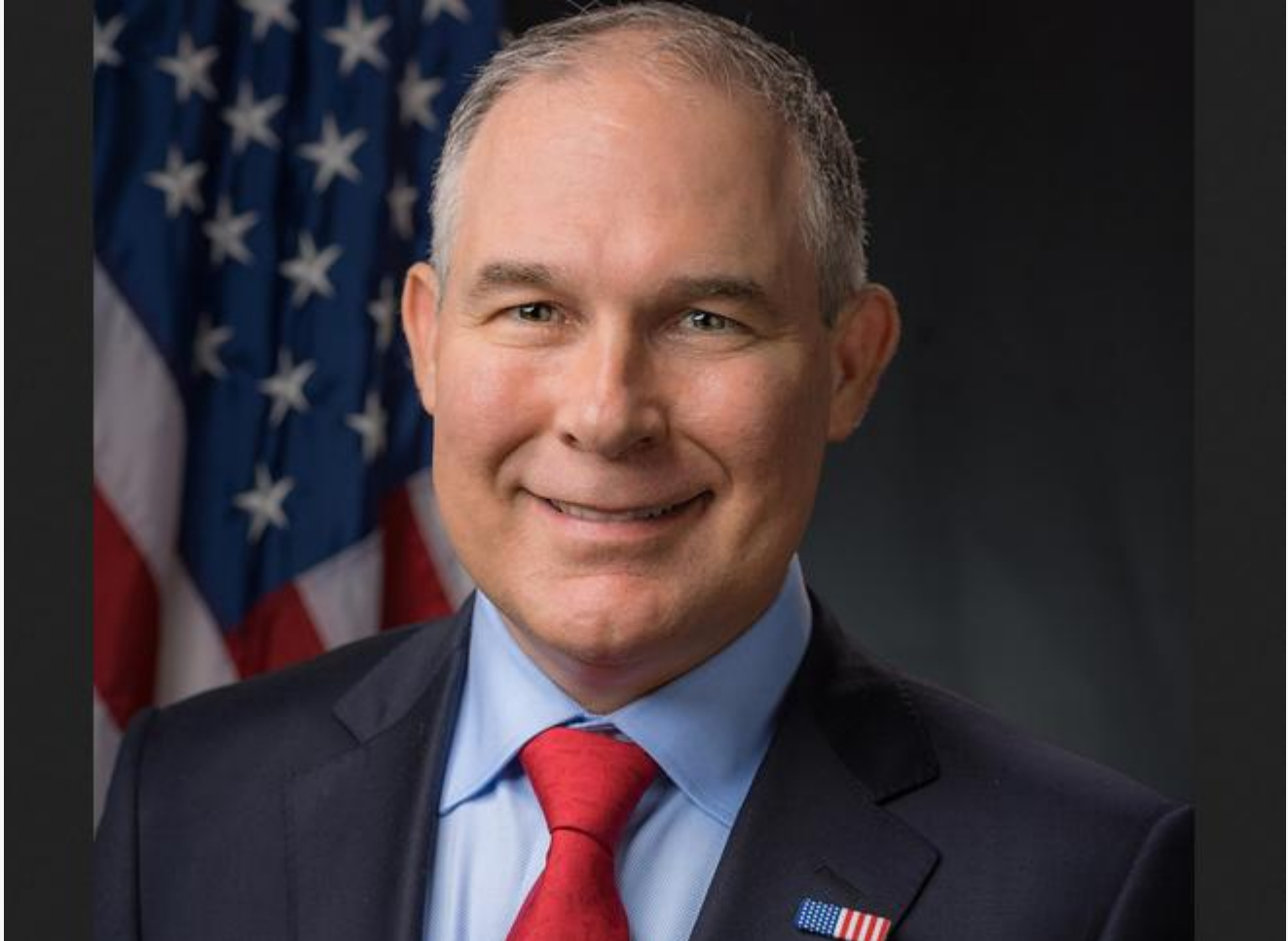


EPA Chief Needs 24-Hour Security after Shutting Down Inefficient and Corrupt Programs
