



EPA Chief Needs 24-Hour Security after Shutting Down Inefficient and Corrupt Programs

US: Scott Pruitt, the Administrator of the EPA, sued the federal agency fourteen times when he was the Attorney General of Oklahoma. He is currently being guarded round the clock because of threats on his life. Since taking over the EPA, he has saved an estimated \$30 billion by cutting waste and fraud. For example, he replaced EPA advisory panels with independent experts instead of people who depend on the EPA for grant money.
