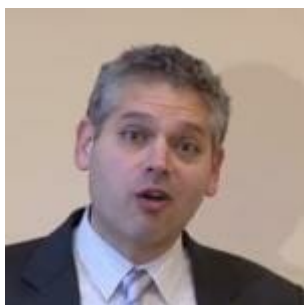


Pro-Gun-Control Candidate for Illinois AG Is Robbed at Gunpoint in Spite of Gun-Control Law in Effect
