



UK Police Chiefs Dropped Grooming Gang Rape Cases Because It Was “Too Much Trouble”

Telford, England: Three police officers who investigated rape and pimping scandal of underage British girls by predominantly Pakistani Muslim men revealed that their superiors dropped the cases because the chiefs said it “was too much trouble”. Social workers often ignored complaints, and one of the chiefs said that the cases were dropped to save the children from having to testify in court. Medical professionals are accused of failing to question why underage girls were having abortions, miscarriages, and taking the morning-after pill. [To fully understand this story, it is necessary to know that most of these girls were teens who were lured into the sex rings and later brutalized and threatened into silence. British tolerance of prostitution may have added to the lackluster response by police and medical professionals. The British government is obsessed with protecting the public image of immigrant criminals.] -GEG

Three police officers who investigated child sex abuse in Telford have revealed just how the victims were failed.

One told the Sunday Mirror he was “horrified” after court orders against more than 20 suspects were abandoned – allegedly after chiefs said it “was too much trouble”.

Another told of the “huge” scale of abuse and said more convictions could have been achieved if the cases had been properly linked at the time.

Meanwhile, the mother of an abused girl who died revealed she gave police a three-page list of suspects – but claimed nothing was done.

The same girl and a fellow 13-year-old were reportedly in a car driven by abusers that was stopped by police – but allowed to go.

The officers came forward after Supt Tom Harding, of West Mercia Police, said he “significantly disputed” our probe and claimed an estimate of 1,000 victims was “sensationalised”.

But a string of experts have supported our figures and today the question remains – why didn’t the police do more?

One of the police whistleblowers said of the feared 1,000 toll: “I don’t think it’s beyond the realms of possibility at all.

“I wouldn’t be surprised. It was the tip of the iceberg.”

Today, Assistant Chief Constable Martin Evans denied court orders were discounted because of the level of work required.

But our sources stood by their account. And going public showed their concern over the true scale of the problem and the police response.

One said: “There were lots of people that were suspected of abuse but not put before the courts.

Self-Driving Uber Kills Woman Crossing the Street During Test of Self-Driving Car

Uber CEO [Dara Khosrowshahi](#) said in a statement on Twitter, "Some incredibly sad news out of Arizona. We're thinking of the victim's family as we work with local law enforcement to understand what happened."

Brexit Betrayed by UK Government of Globalists

UK Prime Minister Theresa May's government has betrayed the Brexit-voting British public by stalling any changes until 2022. The United Kingdom will agree to follow all European Union rules after Brexit and keep the nation's borders open for the duration of the transition period to 2022, with further bad news for fisheries and communities in Northern Ireland as a new agreement was reached in Brussels Monday.

The European Union's chief Brexit negotiator Michel Barnier made the announcement in a joint press conference with Britain's David Davis in Brussels, where the pair presented what was introduced as a "legal text which constitutes a decisive step" towards a final agreement. Revealing the enormous extent to which Theresa May's government has sold out

the Brexit-voting British public, Barnier and Davis spoke on a number of key policy areas including immigration, British control over British laws, and regaining control over British fishing waters.

Speaking first at the meeting with journalists, French politician Barnier said Britain had agreed to continue following all Brussels laws for years after the official Brexit date of March 2019 under the guise of a transition period, but would not be able to challenge or make decisions on that law itself.

Sugar-coating the fact that Britain won't be free from the yoke of EU legislation for years to come, Barnier said: "the United Kingdom will no longer participate in EU decision-making processes because after the 30th of March 2019 you will no longer be a member state."

"Nonetheless, it will preserve all the benefits and advantages of the single market, the customs union, and European policies and will, therefore, be required to respect all European rules just like member states do."

Barnier also made clear that Britain wouldn't have any control over immigration during the transition period either, with all European Union citizens coming to the United Kingdom through the period into the 2020's would have full rights forever, under what he called a "new resident status", saying this would give those citizens "legal certainty."

Yet the whole deal will stand or fall on answering the question over the European Union-British border between Republic of Ireland and Ulster, which has been inflated to a matter of utmost importance – and particularly by those who would see Britain remain locked into the European Union. Just days after British Brexit leader Jacob Rees-Mogg [warned](#) the EU was using Ulster to keep the UK in the single market, Barnier euphemistically referred to the "backstop solution" to Ireland

– keeping Britain’s westernmost region in the customs union.
