



# Judge Tosses Bogus 'Global Warming' Lawsuits Against Big Oil

US District Judge William Alsup shut down a lawsuit filed by liberal mayors in Oakland and San Francisco who sued big oil companies for their alleged impact on climate, claiming damages included sea level rise that has yet to materialize, but is on the way, according to the models cited in the litigation. The judge explained that it would be unfair to blame oil companies who supplied the oil to the public benefitted from it and demanded it.

On Monday, U.S. District Judge William Alsup released a detailed 16 page ruling that ends a years' long effort by liberal mayors in Oakland and San Francisco to sue big oil companies, including Bay Area based Chevron.

The suits by Oakland and San Francisco sought money from oil companies to pay for a sea level rise that has yet to materialize, but is on the way, according to the models cited in the litigation. The cases brought by Oakland and San Francisco were among the first serious efforts by municipalities which sought compensation for the alleged impact of fossil fuels on the climate. The central tenant of the lawsuits brought against the oil companies is the belief that like Tobacco companies, oil companies create a public hazard by continuing the production of fossil fuels.

Judge Alsup noted that the cities of Oakland and San Francisco have inarguably benefited from the production of fossil fuels.

Although remarks to this effect were made by Judge Alsup, the final decision did not attempt to tabulate the grand total of all the costs and benefits provided to the cities by fossil fuels.

None of the suspects speaks English and it is unknown whether they are US citizens.

- **The wake was held Monday for Lesandro Guzman-Feliz, 15, who was beaten and stabbed to death outside a Bronx bodega Wednesday**
- New video has emerged showing the teen being kicked out of the store he was first dragged from as he begged for help
- A separate video shows the moment he was dragged out of the bodega shortly before he was beaten and stabbed to death
- Police in New York and New Jersey have arrested seven suspects
- Authorities received tips on the whereabouts of the suspects, who are allegedly members of a Dominican gang called Trinitarios
- The killing was said to be 'a case of mistaken identity over a sex tape'
- The victim tried to run to the hospital but collapsed outside the medical center, where he was pronounced dead

Thousands attended the wake of the 15-year-old boy who was brutally beaten and stabbed to death by a gang of men outside of a Bronx bodega last week, in what police are saying is a case of mistaken identity regarding a sex tape.

Family, friends and strangers gathered to mourn Lesandro 'Junior' Guzman-Feliz Monday as the innocent teen's mother Leandra Feliz wore a t-shirt with her son's face on it and thanked everyone for attending, saying that her 'heart is broken'.

'He was a sweet kid with a very good heart,' she said to throngs of mourners who wrapped around two blocks as she and his father held a sign that read 'Save our Streets'

'#JusticeforJunior' and '#StoptheViolence'.

The service comes as new surveillance video from inside the bodega emerged showing the teen's final moments as he returns to the store he was originally dragged from and begs for help before being kicked out by employees.

## **Getting Nasty: Homeland Security Official Warned with Decapitated Animal on His Porch**

A senior Department of Homeland Security (DHS) official living in the Washington, DC area found a burnt and decapitated animal on his front porch. Due to increased threats, a DHS official warned employees to keep badges hidden from public, be careful with public conversations and censor their social media posts. They were also advised to keep doors and windows locked and to be aware of unexpected changes in their homes. Last week, WikiLeaks published publicly available personal information of more than 9,000 supposed current and former ICE employees, arguing that it did so for "increasing accountability."

According to an official who is familiar with recent threats directed against the Department of Homeland Security, the department determined that there is now a “heightened threat against DHS employees.” The official said roughly two dozen threats have been made in the last few days.

One specific example: a senior DHS official living in the Washington, D.C. area found a burnt and decapitated animal on his front porch.

On Saturday, Claire Grady, acting deputy secretary of Homeland Security, wrote to employees, “This assessment is based on specific and credible threats that have been levied against certain DHS employees and a sharp increase in the overall number of general threats against DHS employees.” Her memo recommended not displaying work badges in public, being careful with public conversations and being circumspect on social networks. It also recommended DHS employees “always keep doors and windows locked” and “be aware of unexpected changes in and around your home.”

# Planned over Police Shooting Death

Pittsburgh: Protests continue following last week's shooting death by a police officer of Antwon Rose, 17, who was unarmed and fled the scene. Antwon was a passenger in a car that was stopped because it fit the description of a vehicle involved in a drive-by shooting and there were bullet holes in the window. Two semi-automatic weapons were found inside the car and Antwon had an empty 9mm clip in his pocket. The police officer has been placed on administrative leave. Protesters are calling for the District Attorney's ouster as he has not filed charges against the police officer.

Protesters angry over the death of an unarmed teen who was shot by police this week marched Friday for the third straight night down the streets of downtown Pittsburgh.

Four people were arrested as hundreds of demonstrators blocked streets, Allegheny County Police Superintendent Coleman McDonough said.

Police are looking for a black sedan that drove through the crowd late Friday, said Chris Togneri, the city spokesman. No injuries were reported, he said.

Protesters were near PNC Park, where fans were leaving a Pittsburgh Pirates baseball game, when the car drove through, CNN affiliate KDKA reported.

## 'How do you justify that?'

Antwon Rose, 17, was shot by an officer three times on Tuesday as he attempted to flee a car stopped by police. Rose was one of two passengers in the car, which matched the description of a vehicle that had been involved in an earlier shooting, Allegheny County Police said.

East Pittsburgh Police Officer Michael Rosfeld fired on Rose from behind, hitting him in three spots, police said.

The manner of Rose's death was listed as homicide, the Allegheny County Medical Examiner's Office said.

“Three shots in the back, how you justify that?” protesters chanted Friday.

Demonstrators carrying a sign that read, “Fire killer cops,” led hundreds of supporters to the Homestead Grays Bridge, halting traffic for a few hours.

Those arrested face charges for failure to disperse and, at least one, for resisting arrest, McDonough told KDKA.

## **‘He wasn’t that boy’**

Tia Taylor, who went to high school with Rose, addressed the crowd, offering a heartfelt testimony of him.

“He wasn’t the person to be out here doing anything he didn’t have no business doing. He wasn’t that boy,” Taylor, a student at Woodland Hills High School, said through tears.

## **Agenda 21 Alert: Canada to Impose Paris Treaty, Electricity Rates to Soar in 5 States**

Angelo, who hails from Idaho, is concerned that Avista energy company, which operates in five states including Alaska, Oregon, Washington, Montana and Idaho, will be sold to Hydro One, a Canadian company headquartered in Ontario. Canada is a

signatory to the UN Paris climate treaty that mandates a cap-and-trade scheme, and Hydro One has imposed a 70% surcharge on its customers in Ontario. Their winter fuel bills quadrupled over a 10 year period. The 70% surcharge/ carbon tax is used to subsidize unreliable wind and solar power. The sale of Avista energy to Hydro One appears to be a backdoor effort to ensnare the Western states into cap-and-trade taxes and the Paris treaty that Trump rejected. If the sale goes through, Hydro One will control 13 dams that supply power to a large portion of the northwest and Angelo believes that they will try to shut down the dams to make the area unlivable in an Agenda 21 scheme to remove people from the landscape.

## **Lauren Southern's Documentary, Explores White Genocide and the Brewing Civil War in South Africa**

Lauren Southern traveled to South Africa and produced a documentary, *Farmlands*, to investigate tales of gruesome murders of white farmers that the leftist communist government and mainstream media consider a "non-issue", and the possibility of a civil war.

In this film, Lauren Southern examines the case of reported atrocities against white farmers and begins by giving a short history of European settlers, the Dutch East India Trading Company (aka VOC), who arrived in 1652. They purchased Cape Town in 1671 from the the natives of the area, the Khoisan people, formerly known as Hottentots. Because many of the

children of the Europeans were born into indentured servitude, they decided to leave and began the Great Trek in 1836 into the interior to become farmers, known as Afrikaners.

Meanwhile, further north, black Bantu tribes fought each other in a war in 1817, led by a king, Shaka Zulu, and an estimated 1 – 2 million Bantu were massacred. Bantu tribes migrated south and encountered the Afrikaners. The Bohr advancement across the country was mostly peaceful and they bought the land, but the Bantu tribes fought ceaselessly, killing black, white, and Koi. IN 1910, following the surrender of the Bohr to the British, South Africa was formed, uniting colonies as one legislative union.

In 1948, apartheid (separateness) was enforced with bans on mixed marriages, and the Population Registration Act required people to register as black, white, colored or Indian. Many descendants of Bantu tribes were moved to Bantustan areas - black tribal homelands. Apartheid became the focus of global resistance and the minority white ruling party began a brutal crackdown that led to more support for removing apartheid and radicalized anti-apartheid activists.

In 1961, Nelson Mandela co-founded the Spear of Nation (MK), the armed wing of the communist ANC party that rules country today. The MK announced its existence with 57 bombings in one day. Mandela went to prison and resistance to apartheid became more radical.

In 1991, the ruling white National Party released Mandela and ended apartheid. Three years later, Mandela became president and the ANC party won the majority vote. The land issue is an argument over who owns the land of the white farmers.

.

Currently, the country is in chaos. White farmers are being attacked, subjected to extreme torture and killed daily across the country. From 2012 to 2016, violence has increased by 72% and the government tries to cover it up. The murders are horrific and brutal. In one case, a woman's father was executed and the black perpetrators were caught and sentenced to only 15 years, but she said they will be out in 6 years. The police are of little help.

.

The government has implemented the 'Black Economic Empowerment' policy to coerce utilities to reduce the number of white workers to reflect racial make up of country- no more than 8% of white workers, which has led to a reduction in engineers and technicians, adding to water crisis that is killing farms. Louis, a farmer, said that the government is trying to break whites through fuel and property taxes because they want the farmers starving or dead. Ironically, South Africa is dependent on white farmers for food and the angora goat industry contributes to the economy.

The economy is imploding with unemployment between 38% to 50%, a drop in the value of the currency, and a tax base of only 3.1 million people, while 16 million are on welfare (the population of SA is 56 million).

.

White squatter camps are popping up across the country as whites have been forced out of the labor pool and the government refuses to help poor whites. Black groups are anxious to take the land from white farmers and they advocate for violence as they use a false narrative that whites stole the land. A race-based civil war is percolating beneath the

surface. a woman reported that it costs about \$300,000 to leave the country and live somewhere else.

The government is openly calling for the expropriation of white farmers' land, without compensation, and killing whites.
