



Jacksonville Shooter Killed Himself After Murdering 3 People at Video Game Tournament Was an Anti-Trump Leftist

Hollywood celebrities wasted no time in taking to social media on Sunday to politicize the deadly shooting in Jacksonville, Florida, at the Madden 19 tournament, attacking President Donald Trump, Republican lawmakers, and the NRA.

Leading the way was Netflix's *Insatiable* star Alyssa Milano, who urged her followers to "honor" the victims of the shooting "by voting for candidates that reject" the NRA.

New Jersey Couple Raised \$400,000 for Homeless Man on GoFundMe and Kept the Money

Kate McClure ran out of gas in a “sketchy” neighborhood in Philadelphia, and homeless veteran, Johnny Bobbitt, gave her his last \$20 for gasoline, which he fetched for her. McClure and her boyfriend, Mark D’Amico, responded with a GoFundMe campaign to raise \$10,000 so that Bobbitt could get safely through the winter. The campaign raised more than \$400,000 in Bobbitt’s name, but Bobbitt says he has not received the funds. The couple claims to have spent half of the fortune on lawyer fees and finding a house and vehicle for the vet, but the remaining \$200,000 is still in the boyfriend's savings account instead of a trust for the veteran who is now living

under a bridge.

Johnny Bobbitt is back under a bridge just months after a couple raised \$400,000 for him – and then reportedly [kept](#) it.

It seemed like an American Cinderella story: when New Jersey resident Kate McClure ran out of gas in a “sketchy” neighborhood in Philadelphia, 35-year-old homeless veteran Johnny Bobbitt [offered](#) her his last \$20 dollars for gas, which he went and fetched for her himself.

McClure and her boyfriend Mark D’Amico [responded](#) with a GoFundMe campaign to raise \$10,000 so that Bobbitt could get safely through the winter. The story captured the hearts and minds of many readers, and the campaign [raised](#) more than \$400,000 in Bobbitt’s name. This, however, is where the story gets ugly.

The last update to the GoFundMe page described a plan in concert with Bobbitt’s “lawyer” and “financial adviser” to acquire a home and vehicle for him. However, Bobbitt said he never spoke to a lawyer and only met a financial adviser once. The couple claims to have already spent half the money on him in that time – but their story does not seem to check out.

Rather than putting the money into trusts, as was explicitly stated, the remaining \$200,000 is held in one of D’Amico’s savings accounts. While Bobbitt lives under a bridge, McClure has purchased a new BMW and taken vacations to California, Florida, and Las Vegas – all, she claims, on the salary of a receptionist for the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

Rod Rosenstein Sent Cohen Case to Manhattan In Order to Open a New Legal Warfare Front Against Trump

Deputy Attorney General Rod Rosenstein made the decision to turn over the case against Michael Cohen, Trump's former attorney, to attorneys in the Southern District of New York, creating an investigation separate from the Mueller probe. Rosenstein did this to ensure that the witch hunt against President Trump continued if President Trump shut down the Mueller investigation. A source claims that Rosenstein ordered Trump appointee, US Attorney Geoffrey Berman, to recuse himself from prosecuting the Cohen case, leaving Obama leftovers to handle the case. Rosenstein has at least one major conflict-of-interest in prosecuting Trump as he signed off on a FISA warrant to spy on then-candidate Trump using the discredited Steel dossier as evidence.

Rosenstein approved Mueller's referral to Geoffrey Berman on Monday, April 9th. Rosenstein ordered raids on Cohen's residence the following day. It is not clear why or when Berman recused himself from the investigation.

Five States Win \$839 Million Lawsuit Against Obamacare Program's Unconstitutional Tax on States

The Affordable Care Act (ACA), better known as Obamacare, requires medical providers to pay a Health Insurance Provider Fee, even though the ACA exempts states from paying that fee when providing health care. The US Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) during the Obama era created a regulation requiring states to pay the fee anyway, a fee that is styled as a tax on the states. Texas sued in federal court and was joined by Indiana, Nebraska, Kansas, and Louisiana- the states were awarded a total of \$839 million. The mainstream media is ignoring this story because it supports President Trump's

contention that parts of Obamacare are illegal and should be repealed.

Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton is leading a five-state coalition that on Thursday won an \$839 million judgment against the federal government in an Obamacare lawsuit, a massive blow to the Obama administration's namesake legislation.

The Affordable Care Act (ACA, better known as Obamacare) requires medical providers to pay a Health Insurance Provider Fee (HIPF). Even though the ACA exempts states from paying that fee when providing health care, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) during the Obama era created a regulation requiring states to pay the fee anyway, a fee that is styled as a tax on the states.

Paxton sued in federal court, joined by Indiana, Nebraska, Kansas, and Louisiana. The five states' lawsuit argues that this tax/fee is illegal under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) because the ACA clearly exempts states from this payment and also that even if the statute did allow it, such taxes would violate the Tenth Amendment of the Constitution when imposed on sovereign states.

Judge Reed O'Connor of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas agreed on the statutory issue (the APA claim), striking down the Obama HHS rule because it violates the plain language of the ACA law. O'Connor ordered the federal government to pay Texas the \$305 million that the Lone Star State had paid in HIPF fees, as well as the fees of the other states, for a total of \$839 million.

"Obamacare is unconstitutional, plain and simple," Paxton said after Thursday's ruling. "We all know that the feds cannot tax the states, and we're proud to return this illegally collected money to the people of Texas."

Having struck down the HIPF tax on statutory grounds, the

court did not even need to reach the constitutional claim. Under the doctrine of constitutional avoidance, federal courts are supposed to issue constitutional rulings only if there is no lesser law upon which to grant plaintiffs the relief they seek. There is no reason to doubt that the states would have won on their constitutional argument if necessary, however, because the federal government cannot tax states under the Tenth Amendment's intergovernmental tax immunity doctrine.

Surprisingly, it appears that Texas media are ignoring this monumental win for the Lone Star State and the other states also. There has been scant national coverage, as well.

Retired Archbishop Calls for Pope Francis to Resign for Ignoring Sex Abuse Allegations

Archbishop Carlo Maria Vigano, a former nuncio or ambassador for the pope, is calling for Pope Francis to resign, claiming that the pontiff knew about abuse perpetrated by Cardinal Theodore McCarrick, who recently resigned amid accusations that he engaged in sex with adult seminarians as well as

sexually abusing minors. Pope Francis repealed the sanctions that were imposed on McCarrick by prior Pope Benedict who ordered McCarrick out of the public ministry. Pope Francis revoked the sanctions and made McCarrick his trusted counselor.
