Judicial Watch discovered that the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA) Court held no hearings on the surveillance warrant applications from the FBI targeting former Trump campaign adviser Carter Page. There were four warrants issued and three of them were executed after President Trump was elected. The fourth renewal of the warrant was signed under Mueller's reign, implicating him in using the fraudulent document.
