This month, the federal government entered a partial shutdown after Congress was unable to reach a budget agreement, primarily on funding for President Donald Trump's proposed wall along the southern border.

“We simply cannot allow people to pour into the United States undetected, undocumented and unchecked” -Barack Obama, 2005

“I voted numerous times... to spend money to build a barrier to try to prevent illegal immigrants from coming in. And I do think you have to control your borders.” -Hillary Clinton, 2008

Wanting to know if opponents of Trump’s border wall had opinions on these past quotes from Democrat leaders, *Campus Reform*’s Cabot Phillips headed to American University.

But there’s a catch... the students were told the quotes actually came from President Trump.

Upon hearing the quotes, students said Trump’s words were “dehumanizing,” “problematic,” and “jingoist.”

NY City Mayor de Blasio Says Healthcare is a “Right” and Plans to Guarantee Payment of Medical Bills

New York City Mayor Bill de Blasio announced he will be launching a plan to guarantee health care coverage for all residents, which includes illegal immigrants living in the city. He says healthcare is a human right, and he plans to offer this “right” to anyone who lands in New York from another country. The plan will cost taxpayers well over \$100-million and will cover everything from mental health services to well visits, to maternity care for anyone who wants it. He says the ultimate solution is single-payer health insurance for the whole country. [Single payer means government, which means taxpayers, which means you – if you work for a living.]

New York City Mayor Bill de Blasio announced he will be launching a plan to guarantee health care coverage for all residents, which includes illegal immigrants living in the city.

“Health care is a human right. In this city we’re going to make that a reality,” de Blasio said during a press conference Tuesday. “From this moment on, in New York City,

everyone is guaranteed the right to health care. Everyone.”

De Blasio explained a day earlier the plan, referred to as NYC Care, will reach nearly 600,000 New Yorkers and cost taxpayers at least \$100 million. The healthcare-for-all plan is not limited to American citizens and would also include individuals who cannot afford their existing plans.

NYC Care is expected to first launch in the Bronx over the summer and will be fully implemented throughout the city by 2021, according to Bloomberg.

The progressive mayor said he believes NYC Care will act as a springboard for the rest of the country to follow suit and ultimately implement a nationwide universal health care program.

New CA Governor Gavin Newsom Proposes More Healthcare for Illegal Aliens and Restoring the Individual Mandate

New California Governor Newsom proposed extending Medi-Cal, the state's version of Medicaid, to illegal aliens up to the age of 26, rather than 19. Governor Newsom ran on the proposal of providing healthcare to everyone in California, although he could not explain how he would pay for it. California will be the first state in the nation to cover young illegal aliens who are estimated to number 138,000. Newsom promised "sanctuary to all who seek it" in his inaugural address. His budget proposes increasing the size of the subsidies for families who already receive them, and it would make California the first state to make subsidies available to middle income families. In order to force middle-class citizens to pay for the government handouts, Newsom is seeking to restore the individual mandate to purchase health insurance within the state, a law that was terminated at the federal level by President Trump. -GEG

California Governor Gavin Newsom's first act in office was to propose extending state healthcare benefits to more illegal aliens.

On Tuesday, shortly after being sworn in, Newsom – who ran on the proposal of providing healthcare to everyone in California, though he struggled to explain how he would pay for it – signed an executive order taking steps in that direction.

In his first executive order, Newsom directed the state to create a single government purchaser for prescription drugs to increase negotiating leverage with pharmaceutical companies.

Alongside the order, Newsom proposed extending Medi-Cal – the state’s version of Medicaid – to illegal aliens up to the age of 26, rather than 19.

The governor’s forthcoming budget, his office said, “will make California the first state in the nation to cover young undocumented adults through a state Medicaid program.”

That would cover 138,000 “young people in the country illegally,” according to the Associated Press.

“Undocumented young adults should not have to worry about losing their health coverage when they turn 19,” the governor’s office added, saying that the budget proposals, to be presented later this week, would defend Obamacare from “recent federal attacks” and “bring the state closer toward the goal of health care for all.”

In his inaugural address, Newsom promised “sanctuary to all who seek it” – a reference to California’s status as a “sanctuary state” for illegal aliens that refuses to help enforce federal immigration law.

That policy continues to be a lightning rod for national criticism after the murder last month of Corporal Ronil Singh, a legal immigrant and police officer who was allegedly shot and killed by an illegal alien during a traffic stop.

Golden Globes Award Show Rolled Out Flu Shots for Celebrity Audience, Anti-Vaxxers Aren't Laughing

Golden Globe hosts Andy Samberg and Sandra Oh brought out people identified as 'nurses' and told the audience to roll up their sleeves for flu shots. The hosts said the show spent \$50,000 on vaccines to be administered by nurses, but later reports indicated that it was not a real flu vaccine. The point of the whole bit was to call out anti-vaxxers who have been falsely blamed for recent outbreaks of measles and to use ignorant celebrities as role models to convince TV viewers to accept vaccines. Many health professionals praised the gesture on social media.

Anti-vaxxers who tuned in to the Golden Globes on Sunday night took issue with one specific bit.

As LMFAO's song "Shots" started playing, hosts Andy Samberg and Sandra Oh brought out people identified as nurses and told the audience to roll up their sleeves for flu shots. (It's unclear if the shots were real, as one of the people administering them was comedy writer Bowen Yang.)

"You know you wore a sleeveless gown for a reason," Oh told her fellow actresses.

While health professionals praised the gesture – real or not – on social media, those opposed to vaccinating their children had the opposite reaction.

“If you are an anti-vaxxer, just put a napkin on – perhaps over – your head and we will skip you,” Samberg told the Golden Globes crowd.

Heeding his advice to distinguish themselves, anti-vaxxers watching at home started posting selfies with napkins on their heads.

“I will proudly put a napkin on my head. Kids are dying because of these shots! Wake up, America! Can you not see it,” one woman wrote on Facebook, calling the segment “pathetic on so many levels.”

The open border is a pipeline for illegal drugs. Over the past two years, ICE arrested over 266,000 illegal aliens with criminal records, including 100,000 assaults, 30,000 sex crimes, and 4,000 murders.

Trump says he has requested technology to detect drug and weapons transfers across the border, more border agents, immigration judges, more bed space for immigrants, and \$5.7-billion for a barrier. -GEG
