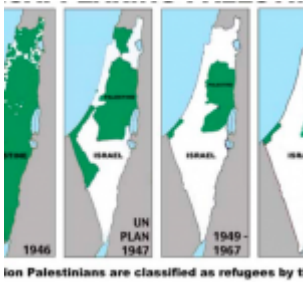




# Permitting the Killing of Babies after Birth is the New Position on Abortion by Leaders within the Democrat Party

Leaders within the Democrat party are profoundly changing the party's position on abortion. New York Governor Andrew Cuomo signed a bill that legalizes abortion up to the moment of birth. # Senate Advances Bill that Penalizes Companies that Boycott Israel

Both Democrat and Republican Senators advanced a pro-Israel bill authorizing US military defense and loan guarantees to Israel. It also gives state and local governments the ability to penalize companies that boycott Israel in protest against Israel's occupation of the West Bank. Companies that oppose Israeli occupation of Palestine will go out of business when they lose government contracts. Both parties in 26 states have passed laws against companies participating in economic boycotts against Israel.

The American Civil Liberties Union has challenged four state laws, winning two judgments in Arizona and Kansas so far with federal courts saying the laws run afoul of the First Amendment by trampling on Americans' expressive conduct. There's no Supreme Court precedent squarely on the subject.

After weeks of a shutdown-inspired filibuster, some Senate Democrats relented Monday and joined Republicans to advance a bill to

and local governments a green light to penalize companies that  
boycott [Israel](#).

The Senate voted 74-19 to head off an initial  
blockade and clear the path for the bill to reach the chamber  
floor  
later this week. The vote also signals that barring a major  
dust-up, the  
legislation likely has enough support to pass.

Democrats had been filibustering for weeks, with  
some objecting to the bill on policy grounds and others  
arguing they  
didn't want to deal with any other issues as long as  
government was  
partially closed.

Now that the shutdown is over, those latter objections  
disappeared.

Republicans called the bill a major piece of "pro-[Israel](#)"  
legislation.

"At its core, the linchpin of it is helping [Israel](#) defend  
itself," said Sen. Marco Rubio, Florida Republican, who  
sponsored the legislation.

# Oregon: Antifa Member Is Killed by Police After Opening Fire on Officers at Middle School

Eugene, Oregon: Charlie Landeros was shot and killed by police when he pulled a handgun on them as they tried to take him into custody during a dispute at his daughter's school. His daughter was in the hallway, and Landeros looked at her just before shooting at the cop. Mr. Landeros was a 'gender-ambiguous' person, an activist against 'police brutality', leader of the Antifa militant group "Red Arm", and founder of "Community Armed Self-Defense". He was wearing a "smash the patriarchy" shirt at the time of the shooting. His backpack was loaded with ammunition. [The school was a gun-free zone. The signs apparently didn't work.] -GEG

Charles

Landeros, 30, was fatally shot in the head by officer Steve Timm at the middle school of his daughter. At the time of the shooting, the leader

of the Antifa militant group "Red Arm" and founder of "Community Armed Self-Defense" was at the middle school resisting arrest. Landeros at the time was involved in a custody dispute with his former wife. He was wearing a "smash the patriarchy" shirt at the time of the shooting.

Landeros was not only a leader in the Far-left militant group out of Eugene, Oregon, but he also was the chief firearms instructor for the organizations. The stated mission of the group is to, "defend the oppressed." Landeros, who identified by non-gender specific pronouns, had a goal to teach and form an armed group to protect members of the LGBTQ+ communities, as well as communities of various cultural backgrounds considered "oppressed".

The secondary goal of his "Red Army" group was the overthrow of what it sees as a fascist government and the installation of a far-left communist regime in the United States. Landeros has been involved in several violent protests around Oregon protesting things such as perceived police brutality against people of color and people who identify as LGBTQ+.

Landeros recently switched his daughter's middle school. When Landeros's ex-wife found out about the transfer she brought custody paperwork to the school showing she had sole control over their daughter's schooling. When a school official notified Landeros, he was enraged and headed to the school. It is unclear why he changed his daughter's school.

School officials asked Landeros to leave the property when he refused to leave the grounds the school staff called a resource officer. Officer Steve Timm responded to the call and once again requested Landeros to leave immediately or face arrest for trespassing and disorderly conduct. He still refused to leave, so Officer Timm called Officer Aaron Johns for back up. The two officers tried to get Landeros out of the school, but Landeros became combative.

It was at this point where the officers informed the member of Antifa that he was under arrest. Landeros pulled out a 9mm handgun and fired two shots at the officers. Officer Johns tried to wrestle the gun away from Landeros. When the two hit the floor struggling for the firearm Officer Timm fired the fatal shot to the head of Landeros killing him

instantly.

Police released the body cam footage to calm unrest in the Antifa community. The footage seems to show that Officer Timm was left with no choice other than shoot Landeros to protect the other officer. It doesn't give a clear reason why Landeros would pull his gun and provides evidence that the officers were not overly physical with an individual trespassing on school grounds.

Lane County District Attorney, Patty Perlow, said that the officers acted correctly and that the use of force was justified.

*"There was no clearer circumstance that the use of deadly force is justified than this," Perlow said.*

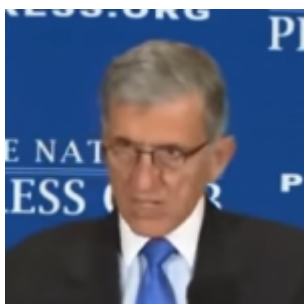
In an unfortunate circumstance, Landeros daughter was in the hallway when Officer Timm was forced to shoot her father. The timing of his daughter walking down the hall appears to be just a coincidence. There would have been no way of Landeros knowing his daughter would be in the hallway, but he did see his daughter before shooting at officers, a fact not lost on the DA.



*“It is unknown why Charles Landeros chose to use deadly force in this circumstance, but he clearly had no regard for the lives of the police officers or the students or staff present, including his child,” said Perlow. “Officer Timm saved the life of Officer Johns, himself and perhaps many others given the number of rounds Charles Landeros had loaded in his weapon.”*

*House committee investigates FCC over 5G infrastructure order*

*The House Energy and Commerce committee has asked the Federal Communications Commission to produce communications records between FCC*

*employees and network operators related to the commission's recent order*

preempting local control and pricing of infrastructure access, alleging that FCC representatives may have acted improperly in support of an initiative that is likely to save operators billions in 5G deployment costs.

“It has come to our attention that certain individuals at the FCC may have urged companies to challenge the order the commission adopted in order to game the judicial lottery procedure and intimidated the agency would look unfavorably toward entities that were not helpful,” wrote committee Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr. (D-New Jersey) and Mike Doyle (D-Pennsylvania), chairman of the subcommittee on communications and technology, in a [letter to FCC Chairman Ajit Pai](#).

“If true, it would be inappropriate for the FCC to leverage its power as a regulator to influence regulated companies to further its agenda in seeking a more friendly court.”

The FCC order focused on easing deployment of 5G infrastructure. The primary tenets of the FCC’s order included:

- Banning local regulations designed to prohibit wireless infrastructure deployment;
- Standardizing the fee structure cities can charge for reviewing small cell projects;
- Establishing a 60-day shot clock for attaching small

- cells to existing structures and 90 days for new builds;
- And setting “modest guardrails on other municipal rules that may prohibit service.”

The order drew [immediate protests from some civic leaders](#) that the FCC was overstepping its bounds and undercutting local control of infrastructure issues. It [went into effect on Jan. 14th](#), after surviving a legal challenge from some municipalities that questioned the FCC’s authority in the case.

But four network operators sued as well, arguing that the FCC did not go far enough in removing infrastructure deployment barriers –

AT&T, for instance, complained that the FCC had refused to adopt the stance that infrastructure placement would be “deemed granted” when a state or local government entity failed to act on an access request

within a reasonable amount of time – and they filed in four different

federal courts. AT&T sued in the D.C. circuit court; Verizon in the

Second Circuit court, which covers New York, Connecticut and Vermont;

Sprint filed in the Tenth Circuit, which covers a number of Midwest and

Western states from Kansas to Utah and Arizona; and [Puerto Rico Telephone Company](#)

filed in the First Circuit court, which has jurisdiction over the

territory as well as several Northeastern U.S. states. Meanwhile, cities

and municipalities had filed legal protests against the FCC’s

*action in the Ninth Circuit, which covers West Coast states including California. A lottery procedure consolidating the cases, triggered by the filing of the cases in multiple federal court districts, initially moved the cases into the Tenth Circuit. A motion from the municipal parties moved it back to the Ninth Circuit, according to the letter from House Democrats.*

## **French Riot Police Shot Yellow-Vest Organizer in the Eye with Rubber Bullet, Leaving Him Handicapped for Life**

Jerome Rodrigues, a 40-year old construction worker, known for his role in organizing Yellow Vest protests, was struck in the eye with a 'flashball' rubber bullet as he was using his video camera over the weekend. His lawyer says the damage to his eye has handicapped him for life. He also was struck with a 'stingball' grenade on his foot. Rodrigues warned protesters to leave the Bastille due to far-left "black bloc" agitators who had arrived to attack the police. -GEG



A 40-year-old French construction worker known for his role in organizing Yellow Vest protests has been “handicapped for life” after he was struck in the eye with a rubber police bullet, his attorney said Sunday.

“He is in shock. He will be handicapped for life. It is a tragedy for him and his family,” said Rodrigues’s lawyer, Philippe de Veulle in an interview with *BFM Television*.

*The bearded Rodrigues, who has become a well-known figure in the “yellow vest” movement with 50,000 followers on Facebook, was live-streaming the protest on the website when he was hit.*

*De Veulle said Rodrigues was struck with a “flashball”, referring to the 40-mm (1.6-inch) rubber projectiles used by French riot police.*

*The devices – which are not used in most European countries – have become deeply controversial in France since the protests began in November, blamed for dozens of serious injuries. [–AFP via Yahoo!](#)*

Speaking from his hospital bed, Rodrigues told *LCI* television that he was also hit with a stingball grenade.

“Everything happened very quickly. They threw a grenade at me

and I  
took a (rubber) bullet. I was attacked twice – a grenade to  
the foot,  
and the bullet.”

In a video of the incident, Rodrigues can be heard warning  
protesters to leave the Bastille due to far-left “black bloc”  
agitators who had arrived to attack the police.

## **Witness Testified that Mexican Drug Lord, ‘El Chapo’, Bribed Former President Peña Nieto with \$100-Million**

Enrique Peña Nieto, who was Mexico’s president from 2012 until  
last December, took a \$100-million bribe from drug lord, El

Chapo Guzman, according to Alex Cifuentes, a Colombian, who was the right-hand man of El Chapo Guzman until his capture in 2013. Guzman was extradited to the United States in January, 2017, to face charges of trafficking cocaine, heroin, and other drugs into the country and he currently is on trial. Peña Nieto denies the accusation. Journalists reported that, Under Peña Nieto's regime, Mexican cartels grew in power as the former president's government appeared to be unable or unwilling to stop cartel violence. Meanwhile, key cartel figures were suspiciously released from prison. Cifuentes testified that Mexican police, not only allowed the cartel to traffic narcotics, but they also participated in trafficking, selling the drugs themselves. -GEG

Sinaloa drug lord Joaquin "El Chapo" Guzman paid a \$100 million bribe to former Mexican President Enrique Peña Nieto in 2012, according to testimony given in a New York federal court on Tuesday.

The testimony was given by Colombian drug lord Alex Cifuentes Villa, who said that Peña Nieto first contacted Guzman "about the time he was elected president in late 2012, asking the drug lord for \$250 million in exchange for calling off a nationwide manhunt for him," [The New York Times](#) reported.

"Mr. Guzman paid a bribe of \$100 million to President Peña Nieto?" Guzman attorney Jeffrey Lichtman asked Cifuentes during cross-examination.

“Yes,” Cifuentes answered.

Cifuentes claimed that Guzman responded to Nieto’s offer by making a \$100 million counteroffer.

“The message was that Mr. Guzmán didn’t have to stay in hiding?” Lichtman asked.

“Yes,” Cifuentes responded, adding: “that very thing is what Joaquin said to me.”

Cifuentes admitted to multiple crimes in court, including being involved in a murder plot in Canada, buying explosives from drug traffickers, paying off a judge in Ecuador, and kidnapping an official.

Cifuentes testified that Guzman paid off multiple Mexican officials and, on at least two occasions, “gave the Mexican military between \$10 million and \$12 million to launch operations to ‘either kill or capture’ associates of the Beltrán-Leyva brothers during his war with them.”

The Times also notes that Cifuentes testified that Mexican police not only allowed the cartel to traffic narcotics but that they also

participated  
in trafficking, selling the drugs themselves.

Nieto's ties to Mexican drug cartels have been known for years, as he has been previously linked to the cartels.

An investigation released in 2016 revealed that "a series of shell companies had been used by members of the Juarez cartel to funnel funds into Peña Nieto's 2012 election," Breitbart's Border and Cartel team [reported](#).

"The investigation was carried out by Mexican award winning journalist Carmen Aristegui and her team; the subsequent scandal became known as Monexgate for the cash cards that were given out during Peña Nieto's campaign."

"In addition to receiving funds from cartel operatives, Peña Nieto's campaign was run by another politician who has been singled out in international court hearings as a surrogate for Los Zetas," Journalists Ildefonso Ortiz and Brandon Darby continued in their report. "Under Peña Nieto, Mexican cartels only grew in power as his government appear[ed] to be unable or unwilling to stop the cartel violence," adding, "key cartel figures have been suspiciously released

from prison while his government officials claim[ed] to be improving security conditions.”

The Sinaloa Cartel, which Guzman ran, is the most prolific drug trafficking organization in the world and controls the overwhelming majority of the drug trade in the United States.

# **New Migrant Caravan from Central America to US Has Grown to 12,000 People**

A new migrant caravan from Central America reportedly has grown to 12,000 people. The caravan is headed toward Mexico's southern border, and Mexican officials are processing 'humanitarian' visas to allow the migrants to travel legally. Although the Mexican government is inviting members of the caravan to remain in Mexico to work, there is little doubt that the motivation for most migrants is to reach the welfare paradise called the United States. -GEG

**The ranks of a new Central American migrant caravan reportedly grew in size to more than 12,000 as of Friday. The caravan is now heading to Mexico's southern border.**

Mexican immigration officials in the city of Ciudad Hidalgo, which borders Guatemala, are establishing procedures to expedite the process



in which to approve one-year humanitarian visas for members of the Central American migrant caravan who are arriving daily. The one-year humanitarian visas, promised by Mexico's new President Andrés Manuel López Obrador, is a newly adopted policy which allows migrants to legally travel and work during their stay in Mexico.

The new policy of handing out humanitarian visas began on January 17 in response to the new caravan of primarily Honduran migrants who left their home country and headed towards the Mexican border on January 15. Officials originally estimated the caravan's size at about 2,000. Mexico now claims the caravan's population swelled to over 12,000 migrants, [according to](#) local media and Breitbart Texas sources.
