



Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez's Chief of Staff Ran a \$1 Million Slush Fund By Diverting Campaign Cash to His Own Companies

The National Legal and Policy Center, a right-leaning government watchdog group, filed a complaint against Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez's chief of staff, Saikat Chakrabarti, 33, who set up two PACs and then funneled over \$1 million in political donations from the PACs into two of his own private companies. Campaign finance attorneys said there was no way of telling where the political donations went, meaning they could have been pocketed or used by the company to pay for off-the-books campaign operations. If AOC had control over a PAC that was working to get her elected, then she is potentially in very big trouble.

Two political action committees founded by Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez's top aide funneled over \$1 million in political donations into two of his own private companies, according to a complaint filed with the

Federal
Election Commission on Monday.

The cash transfers from the PACs – overseen by Saikat Chakrabarti, the freshman socialist Democrat’s chief of staff – run counter to her pledges to increase transparency and reduce the influence of “dark money” in politics.

Chakrabarti’s companies appear to have been set up for the sole purpose of obscuring how the political donations were used.

Washington State Health Secretary Claims Lawmakers Are Receiving Death Threats for Proposing Mandatory Vaccines Amid Measles Outbreak

Washington State Health Secretary John Wiesman has asked the federal government to push health experts and health-care providers to educate the public about the importance of getting vaccinations in reaction to a measles epidemic that has affected 75 people, most under the age of ten, throughout the Pacific Northwest. Parents are deciding not to vaccinate their children due to links with autism. Weisman said that a very well-organized and connected group of a small number of folks who are having a huge impact, although only 1.3% of children under two years old are unvaccinated. He said that people have stalked and even threatened to kill Washington state legislators who've proposed measures restricting parents from opting out of immunizations for their children. Canadian PM Justin Trudeau Under Fire for Pressuring His AG to Cut a Deal and Stop Prosecution of a Corporation on Charges of Fraud

Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has been accused of pressuring his former attorney general, Jody Wilson-Raybould, to cut a deal with SNC-Lavalin, an engineering and construction company that is facing corruption charges, and then retaliating against her by 'demoting' her when she refused to play ball. Now another minister, Jane Philpott, has quit saying it was
“untenable” for her to continue due to “serious concerns”
raised by the case.

Socialist Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez Burns Resources While Decrying Global Warming and Claiming the World Will End in 12 Years

The New York Post analyzed Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez' (AOC) campaign spending that revealed her hypocrisy in pushing the Green New Deal on Americans while she herself enjoyed using car services instead of the subway that had a stop 1-minute from her headquarters. AOC's campaign logged 1,049 car service transactions totaling over \$23,000 between May 16, 2017, and Dec. 31, 2018, The Post found. Her campaign once booked 26 car-service transactions in a single day.

Patrick Moore, the co-founder of Greenpeace exposed her Green New Deal for failing to plan on how to feed 8 billion people without using fossil fuels. In addition, he criticized her hypocrisy and her excuse of living in the "world as it is" by stating that the world offers the option of trains instead of planes and the subway instead of a taxi.

Freshman New York Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez responded to

The Post's report on her giant carbon footprint by saying she's just "living in the world."

"I also fly and use AC," the Green New Deal-touting pol tweeted Saturday night. "Living in the world as it is isn't an argument against working towards a better future."

Patrick Moore, a former Greenpeace Canada president who now opposes the environmentalist group, issued a series of tweets over the weekend shredding Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez for her Green New Deal.

Mr. Moore, a scientist and author who routinely speaks out against the "eco-fascist" movement, took Ms. Ocasio-Cortez to task for her proposal to transition the country completely off fossil fuels in the next 10 years, saying her plan would result in "mass death."

"Pompous little twit," he tweeted.

"You don't have a plan to grow food for 8 billion people without fossil fuels, or get food into the cities. Horses? If fossil fuels were banned every tree in the world would be cut down for fuel for cooking and

heating. You would bring about mass death.”

“The problem with @AOC is she doesn’t know whether or not she knows what she is talking about,” he wrote. “Makes it harder to think straight.”

Mr. Moore was reacting to a tweet by Ms. Ocasio-Cortez, a democratic socialist, who defended herself for proposing the Green New Deal while still using major carbon emitters like airplanes and air conditioning.

“I also fly [in planes] & use A/C,” Ms. Ocasio-Cortez tweeted in response to a New York Post article that slammed her for “gas-guzzling car rides.”
