



# Registered Sex Offender Read to Young Children in Drag Queen Storytime at the Houston Library

Houston, Texas: Alberto Garza, who calls his drag queen persona Tatiana Mala Nina, is a six foot, 200-pound male sex offender who was convicted in 2008 of sexually assaulting an eight-year-old boy. He was one of the readers in the Houston Public Library's Drag Queen Storytime for young children, which is funded with taxpayer dollars. A group of parents, known as Mass Resistance, discovered the criminal background on Garza after the library failed to perform a background check. Mass Resistance sued the city to stop the program, claiming that the government sponsoring "secular humanism" which violates the Constitution's Establishment Clause on religion, but the lawsuit was dismissed.

A registered child sex offender has been reading to children at Houston Public Library as part of its Drag Queen Storytime.

A group called Mass Resistance, which has been trying to put an end to the program, contacted KHOU about the child sex offender.

Mass

Resistance claims it had been asking the City of Houston for months to disclose information about the drag queens, and when requests went unanswered, they did their own digging and made the shocking link.

A media spokesperson for the library confirmed one of the program's drag queens, Tatiana Mala Nina, is Alberto Garza, a 32-year-old child sex offender. In 2008, he was convicted of assaulting an 8-year-old boy.

"Most parents would not allow that individual to sit in this library and be held up as a role model to our children. Shame on you, Mayor (Sylvester) Turner!" said Tracy Shannon with Mass Resistance.

In a statement, the Houston Public Library admits they didn't do a background check on Garza and said Garza will not be involved in any future library programs.

# **President Trump Issued First Veto Rejecting Bill to Block His Emergency Declaration on the Southern US Border**

The president vetoed a bill blocking his emergency declaration. Twelve Republican Senators who objected to Trump's emergency declaration include Lamar Alexander, Roy Blunt, Susan Collins, Mike Lee, Jerry Moran, Lisa Murkowski, Rand Paul, Rob Portman, Mitt Romney, Marco Rubio, Pat Toomey and Roger Wicker. Trump said that over a million illegal aliens were set to rush the Southern border, including a 2000% increase of migrants from Central America trying to claim asylum. In addition, there is not enough room to house the immigrants that come over the border. The US Congress refuses to pass legislation to change catch-and-release policies that allow illegal aliens to stay in the US while awaiting court hearings, in addition to allowing chain migration, birthright citizenship, visa lottery and unfair asylum policies to remain. Generous health and welfare benefits act as a magnet for immigration.

“Today, I am vetoing this resolution,” Trump said. “Congress has the freedom to pass this resolution and I have the duty to veto it. And I’m very proud to veto it.”

The president defied Speaker Nancy Pelosi, Congressional Democrats, and the [“dirty dozen”](#) Senate Republicans who joined them by signing his veto in a public ceremony at the White House.

He described the Congressional attempt to stop him as a “dangerous” and “reckless” resolution that was “a vote against reality.”

Trump said that over a million illegal aliens were set to rush the Southern border, including a 2000 percent increase of migrants from Central America trying to claim asylum.

“The vast majority are rejected, but smuggling operations making a tremendous amount of money, like they’ve never made before, are using these people to crash the system,” Trump said. “Our

immigration system

is stretched beyond the breaking point.”

He also noted that despite record numbers of apprehensions at the border, there was not enough space to detain them all.

“There’s absolutely nothing we can do. We’re bursting at the seams,

you can only hold so much,” he said. “The only option then is to release

them, and you can’t do that either because when you release them they

come into our society and in many cases, they are stone cold criminals.”

Trump noted 59 different national emergency previous declarations by

past presidents that were frequently used to assist foreign countries.

# Christchurch, New Zealand: Mass Shooting in Two Mosques, 49 Killed

A mass shooting in New Zealand is linked to American politics in a strange manifesto that is a mixture of motives and ideologies. As usual, the event is being used as an excuse to crack down on peaceful citizens' rights to have guns to protect themselves from such shootings. -GEG

New Zealand: Last Friday, a shooter walked into a packed mosque in Christchurch and opened fire on worshipers, live-streaming the act to social media. After killing 41 people, he drove to another mosque and murdered seven more. One more person died in the hospital. Brendon Tarrant, from Australia, was arrested as the prime suspect, and two more men and a woman also were arrested as possible accomplices.

Shortly before the attack, Tarrant published a 75-page manifesto with the title 'The Great Replacement,' vowing revenge against Muslim immigrants, calling them invaders. The content of Tarrant's manifesto raises the possibility that it may have been written, not by him, but by someone or group that seeks to create public opinion against those who oppose mass immigration. For example, he is described in the media as a white supremacist, right-wing extremist, but in his manifesto, he says that China is the "nation with the closest

political and social values to my own.” Tarrant is an Australian, but his manifesto is obsessed with American politics and culture. He blames black-American conservative, Candace Owens, for his violence and he advocates race war between the American right and left.

As usual, politicians are using this shooting as an excuse to crackdown on the right of law-abiding citizens to defend themselves. New Zealand’s Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern sprang into action immediately and called for stricter gun-control laws. On Saturday, she wore a hijab, apparently to show solidarity with the victims.

# Michigan's Attorney General to Document 'Hate' and 'Bias' While Surveilling Individuals and Groups on the SPLC's Hate List

Attorney General Dana Nessel has partnered with the Michigan Department of Civil Rights to document incidents of hate and bias that don't rise to the level of criminal or civil infractions. Critics are concerned that the collection of data could be weaponized to shut down conservatives and other groups who oppose abortion, gay marriage and immigration. Nessel said she would focus her surveillance on 31 Michigan organizations that appear on the Southern Poverty Legal Center's (SPLC) list of hate groups. The SPLC list is a political tool used to harass and smear conservative groups.

Combating hate crimes is a worthy endeavor. But the new campaign announced by Attorney General Dana Nessel has the real potential to morph into thought policing.

Nessel,



in partnership with Agustin Arbulu, director of the Michigan Department of Civil rights, say they will create a process to document incidents of hate and bias that don't rise to the level of criminal or civil infractions.

That could translate to speech or expressions of opinion that some may find offensive, but are protected by the First Amendment. Bias is protected by the Constitution until it infringes on the rights and freedoms of others, and hate is often in the eye of the beholder.

If what Nessel and Arbulu are targeting are words, thoughts and opinions, this could easily become a weapon to shut down groups they find abhorrent, but are operating within the law.

That's not the charge of their offices.

There's reason to worry that's the direction this will take.

Nessel says she'll start her surveillance with the 31 Michigan organizations that appear on the Southern Poverty Legal Center's list of

## **The Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC) Fired Its Founder Amid Allegations of Sexual Harassment and Retaliation**

The Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC) has fired Morris Dees, 82, its co-founder and former chief litigator, for alleged unspecified 'misconduct'. Several SPLC employees reportedly wrote a joint email after a senior attorney resigned and accused Dees of sexual harassment and the SPLC of cover-ups and retaliation. The SPLC is widely known as an anti-Christian, anti-conservative, and anti-free-speech hate group and is embroiled in at least three lawsuits. Many of the Internet's largest social-networking sites and search engines

rely on the SPLC as the authority of what is considered “hate speech” in America while the law firm expands its definitions of hate groups and extremists. Recent tax filings show the SPLC with more than \$450 million in assets.

For fair-minded observers, this has been a bad week for the credibility of the two most aggressive (and punitive) “watchdogs” of the right – Media Matters and the Southern Poverty Law Center. Thanks to Peter Haddon at the Daily Caller News Foundation, we discovered the [stunning hypocrisy](#) of Media Matters president Angelo Carusone. The man who helms an organization that combs through the past of every conservative public figure looking for evidence of hate and bigotry has his own [history of hateful posts](#).

And now the SPLC faces its own internal challenge. Yesterday, the SPLC [fired its legendary co-founder](#), Morris Dees, for unspecified “inappropriate conduct” and then hired an “outside organization” to conduct a “comprehensive assessment” of its “internal climate and workplace practices.” According to the *Los Angeles Times*, [the SPLC just might have a tolerance problem](#):

*The Times has also learned that the organization, whose leadership is predominantly white, has been wrestling with complaints of workplace mistreatment of women and people of color. It was not immediately clear whether those issues were connected to the*

*firing of  
Dees, who is 82.*

*Also Thursday, employees sent correspondence to management demanding reforms, expressing concerns about the resignation last week of a highly respected black attorney at the organization and criticizing the organization's work culture.*

*A letter signed by about two dozen employees – and sent to management and the board of directors before news broke of Dees' firing – said they were concerned that internal “allegations of mistreatment, sexual harassment, gender discrimination, and racism threaten the moral authority of this organization and our integrity along with it.”*

# **'Operation Varsity Blues' Spurs a Class-Action Lawsuit Against Universities and a Second \$500 Billion Lawsuit Against the Defendants**

"Operation Varsity Blues" is an FBI sting that netted indictments of 50 parents, college coaches and administrators, including Felicity Huffman, Lori Loughlin and her designer husband, Mossimo Giannulli. A class-action lawsuit filed by students and parents against Stanford University, USC, UCLA, the University of San Diego, the University of Texas, Yale and Georgetown, accused the schools of unfair competition and violations of consumer law. In a second lawsuit, Jennifer Kay Toy, a school teacher from Oakland, California, is suing the well-heeled defendants and other alleged participants in the multi-million dollar bribery case, claiming that her son, Joshua, who had a 4.2 GPA, was not accepted at top schools where he applied because the admissions system was rigged. Toy is seeking \$500 billion in damages.

The money in this bribery scandal is minuscule compared to government payments to colleges and universities to promote government lines of propaganda. For example, Yale University received approximately \$480 million in federal funds in 2015. But the media is silent on this outrageous use of taxpayer

money.

A group of students and parents have filed a federal lawsuit seeking class-action status against the University of Southern California, UCLA and other colleges named in this week's sprawling admissions scandal, saying their admissions process was "warped and rigged by fraud." Prosecutors revealed Tuesday that 50 people, including [33 parents](#) and a number of college coaches, face charges in [carrying out a scheme in which wealthy people](#) used their money to game the admissions system at some of the nation's elite universities.
