Did China's Coronavirus Escape from the Wuhan Institute that Is Linked to the Communist Country's Biological Warfare Program?

Academics from the University of Hong Kong (HKU) now estimate that the number of infected in Wuhan has reached 43,590, a staggering 1456% higher than the official figure which stands at 2800. The Chinese government appears to not believe its own figure, as it has allocated \$9 billion in funding to combat the virus, and it has quarantined 60 million people.

The Wuhan Institute of Virology, about 20 miles from the seafood market that is the reported origin of the outbreak, has been studying coronavirus since at least 2016. Data shows 13 of the 41 initial cases of Wuhan Coronavirus had no link to the seafood market. The Wuhan Institute meets biosafety-level-4 standards, qualifying it to handle the most dangerous pathogens, and it is linked to China's Biological Warfare Program.

The mainstream media remains silent on the shipment of exceptionally virulent viruses from Canada's National Microbiology Laboratory (NML) that ended up in China in March 2019. After an investigation, Xiangguo Qiu, a prominent Chinese Canadian virologist who was the head of vaccine development at the Special Pathogens Program at NML, was kicked out of the Canadian government research facility, along with her biologist husband, and a number of Chinese students. Critics speculated that she may have transferred intellectual property to China and could be a bio-warfare agent.

This comes as a growing body of evidence suggests the disease did not originate in a seafood wet market as the Chinese government claims.

Xiangguo Qiu is an outstanding Chinese scientist born in Tianjin. She primarily received her medical doctor degree from Hebei Medical University in China in 1985 and came to Canada for graduate studies in 1996. Later on, she was affiliated with the Institute of Cell Biology and the Department of Pediatrics and Child Health of the University of Manitoba, Winnipeg, not engaged with studying pathogens.
