Police Will Protect Hypocrite Chicago Mayor Lightfoot’s Home from Violent Protesters as She Encourages BLM

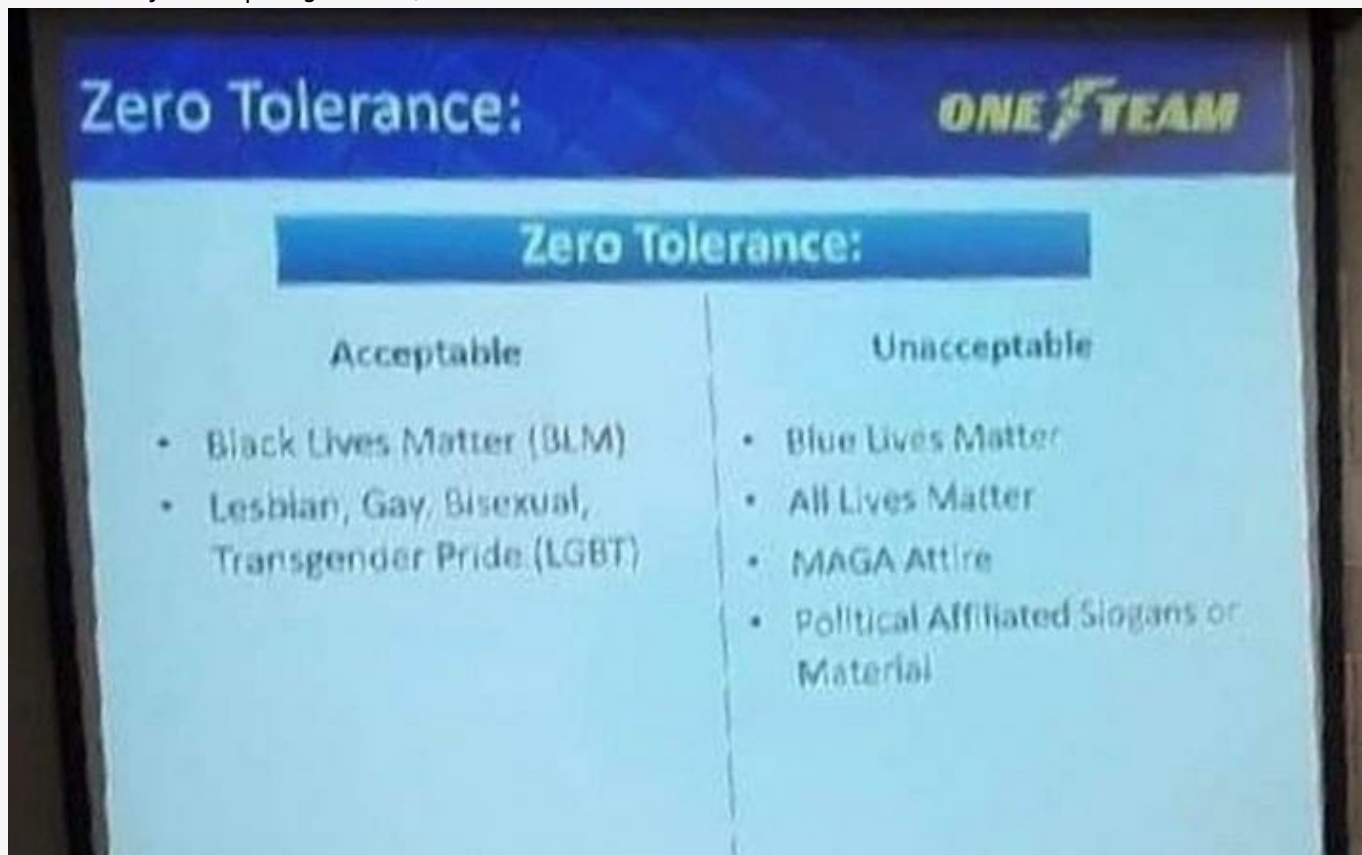
