

# Republicans Announce New Immigration Reform Plan



Republicans announced the bipartisan 'Dignity Plan', which includes protections for Dreamers, the estimated 800,000 DACA recipients who came to the US undocumented as children, as well as a ten-year path for those who lived in the shadows here in the US. The proposal also plans for allowing immigrant non-felons a path to legal status. -GEG

Washington D.C – During the same week Democrats in the U.S. House were expected to move ahead with their first effort at immigration reform during the current Congress, Republican lawmakers announced a new plan for reform.

U.S Rep. Fred Upton, R-St. Joseph, along with a group of several GOP lawmakers including U.S. Sen. Lindsey Graham, R-S.C., and U.S. Rep. Maria Salazar, R-Fla., unveiled proposed immigration reforms during a news conference in Washington Wednesday, March 17, 2021,
