

Largest US Teachers Union Promotes Critical Race Theory and Vows to Fight Critics, Including Parents

The National Education Association, the largest teachers' union with 2.3-million members, recently passed a resolution to promote critical race theory (CRT) in all 50 states and 14,000 local K-12 school districts. CRT is a Marxist program that pits racial groups against each other, asserts that minorities are disadvantaged because of their race, condemns capitalism, criticizes patriarchy, and blames 'white supremacy' for almost everything. The National Education Association has vowed to "fight back" against those opposing CRT, including grassroots parent organizations, and pledged to help teachers "fight back against anti-CRT rhetoric." Last month, the Loudoun County School Board in Virginia met to hear public comments on the curriculum that includes teaching CRT and transgenderism to students. 259 parents signed up to speak, but the assembly then was called "unlawful" and shut down by the Board. The crowd cheered after former Virginia State Senator Dick Black spoke out against transgender programs being pushed on children. Several parents were arrested by police. -GEG
