## January 6 Anniversary: AG Garland Vows to Go After More Protesters at the Capitol, Ignores Leftist Criminals

On January 5th, a still unidentified suspect planted two pipe bombs at the RNC and DNC DC Headquarters in Washington DC the night before the massive January 6th rally at the Ellipse in Washington DC. The FBI offered a reward of \$50,000 for information on the individual who planted pipe bombs. Months after January 6 protests, it was learned that the US Congress was evacuated on January 6th due to a pipe bomb threat — It was not because of the pro-Trump protesters.

Republican Senator Ted Cruz described January 6th as a violent terrorist attack.
