

Unbelievable News Out of Spain – Air Conditioning Cut in the Height of Summer

Spain's socialist government is actually imposing a decree that bans air conditioning below 27°C (80.6°F) in all public and commercial places including airports, public transport, restaurants, cinemas and more. The energy cut is said to reduce dependence on Russian gas and oil by only 7%. The new policy is now being "recommended" for households, and is likely to become mandatory in homes at some point. The government is going ahead despite violating a labor law which states the temperature can be no higher than 25°C (77°F).
