



Analyst Refutes Six Huge Lies by the Mainstream Media about the Migrant Caravan

Buck Sexton, former CIA analyst, handily refutes six lies told by the mainstream media and politicians about the migrant caravan. The media lied that it was mostly women and children in the caravan, most of the migrants were sincere asylum seekers, there were no criminals in the caravans, Obama said that the caravans were so far away that it didn't matter, the caravans were not funded by outside organizations, and Senator Kamala Harris said that it was wrong to deploy US military troops at the border. But the military was needed as support for the border patrol because migrants tried to stampede the border. Sexton made the point that under international law, asylum seekers are required to accept asylum from the first country they enter where their lives are no longer under mortal threat, but they have refused offers of asylum from Mexico.



Mexico: 100 Migrants, Including Children, Kidnapped. Zetas Drug Cartel, Deserters from the Mexican Special Forces, Is Likely Culprit.

An estimated 100 migrants, including children, were kidnapped in Puebla, Mexico, where a bloody turf war has been unfolding between rival cartels Jalisco New Generation and Los Zetas. A human rights commission official said that the federal government has put “strong pressure” on transportation companies to not pick up migrants along the way, which forced them to walk through an unsafe area known as “the largest grave in the country, where hundreds of people have disappeared.” As many as 20,000 migrants a year are kidnapped and ransomed by criminal gangs, and three out of five women and girls are raped during migrant journeys, according to human-rights group Amnesty International.

About 100 migrants, including children, have been kidnapped during their long trek to the United States – presumably by the dangerous drug cartel Los Zetas, according to a new report.

The migrants weren’t among the thousands who arrived in Mexico City on Monday, Arturo Peimbert, the ombudsman for the human-rights commission in Oaxaca, Mexico, [told HuffPost Mexico](#).

Peimbert said the group was kidnapped in Puebla state while trying to reach the capital from Veracruz – where a bloody turf war has been unfolding between rival cartels Jalisco New Generation and Los Zetas.

He said the federal government has put “strong pressure” on transportation companies to not pick up migrants along the way – which forced them to walk through an unsafe area known as “the largest grave in the country, where hundreds of people have disappeared,” [according to a translation by Britain’s Independent newspaper](#).

The abducted migrants were likely turned over to Los Zetas, Peimbert said.

The Zetas are “one of the most powerful and violent criminal organizations in Mexico,” according to information from the US State Department.

The group was formed by deserters from the Mexican Special Forces and has made a name for itself working as a security force and cocaine trafficker for the Gulf Cartel.

Zetas have been known to prey on migrant caravans and often ransom travelers unlucky enough to be caught up in their web, according to Al Jazeera.

In 2011, Zetas rounded up and executed 193 migrants fewer than 100 miles from the US-Mexico border in what came to be known as the San Fernando Massacre, according to Mexican newspaper Milenio.

In one instance, the gang marched 72 people at gunpoint to a farm and shot them in the back one by one, according to Al Jazeera. Just two people escaped with their lives.

Chris Farrell of Judicial Watch Was Banned from Fox News for Saying the “Soros-Occupied State Department” Is Funding the Caravan

Last week, [Fox News](#) banned Chris Farrell, who is the director of investigations and research for Judicial Watch after he claimed on the Lou Dobb’s Show that the “Soros-occupied State Department” was funding the large caravan of migrants at the US border. Apparently, this statement of simple truth was viewed by Fox News as anti-Semitic.

Texas Rep. Louie Gohmert fired back at those who accuse him and others of anti-Semitism for criticizing liberal billionaire financier George Soros.

At the end of a segment on Wednesday night’s “Lou Dobbs Tonight,” Gohmert said, “It’s not anti-Semitic to [criticize Soros](#), and Israel issued a statement a year ago saying just that.”

Gohmert’s televised comments came less than a week after Judicial Watch’s Chris Farrell [was banned](#) from Fox-affiliated networks after accusing the “Soros-occupied State Department” of funding the caravan of migrants on its way through Mexico

to the United States, a claim that the Texas congressman himself [has echoed](#).

The left has made a concerted attempt to link any criticism of the billionaire financier with anti-Semitism. In an [article titled](#), “‘Dripping with poison of antisemitism’: the demonization of George Soros,” The Guardian’s Jason Wilson makes his case:

From the racist white nationalist site the Daily Stormer to major conservative media stars, the right has been

increasingly united over the last decade in seeing the hidden hand of Soros, whom they frequently describe as a “globalist”, in all manner of events.

He has been falsely accused by the right of orchestrating alleged violence from so-called “antifa” groups, manipulating the world economy, being a wartime Nazi collaborator and sponsoring the entirely fictional project of “white genocide.”

As does Democratic Rep. Adam Schiff, [who told](#) CNN’s Jake Tapper on Sunday that attempts to link Soros to the caravan is akin to a “blood libel” against Jews.

In a statement to The Daily Caller, Rep. Gohmert doubled-down on his criticism of Soros:

“The alt-left media, including the New York Times, has decided to provide an all out defense of their beloved, self-identified and remorseless former Nazi collaborator of Jewish lineage, who even the Israeli government knows well is not their friend. George Soros, an anti-God, anti-Israel billionaire, is perhaps the largest ever global funder of efforts to undermine America’s Constitution. Anyone who puts this much effort into the destabilization of America and the destruction of Israel deserves to be called out for his actions.”

The Texas congressman also [included a link to a statement](#) from Israel’s Ministry of Foreign Affairs that essentially accused the billionaire financier of undermining “Israel’s democratically elected governments by funding organizations that defame the Jewish state and seek to deny it the right to defend itself.”

Honduras: Video Shows Women with Children Are Being Given Cash to Join the Caravan to Storm the US Border

The caravan from Honduras that seeks to storm the US border has tripled in size to more than 4,000 people in just two days, as throngs of women with children were filmed being paid to join the caravan. Congressman Matt Gaetz (R-FL) questioned why the caravan was deployed just before the midterm election, as deportation and separating children from parents who cross into the US illegally is a hot-button issue that cannot be easily solved due to an [Obama-era court ruling](#). Gaetz also suggested George Soros and NGOs funded the scheme. President Trump issued a stern warning to Honduran President Hernandez threatening to cut US aid immediately if the caravan was not stopped.

Republican Rep. Matt Gaetz shared footage Wednesday showing women and children being paid cash to join the migrant caravan that is hurdling toward the U.S. Southern border.

The latest migrant caravan heading in the direction of the United States border doubled in size between Saturday and Monday, prompting a concerned statement from a U.S. embassy. Will Mexico be able to stop the caravan before it reaches the U.S. border?

Reuters reports:

Up to 3,000 migrants crossed from Honduras into Guatemala on Monday on a trek northward, after a standoff with police in riot gear and warnings from Washington that migrants should not try to enter the United States illegally.

The crowd more than doubled in size from Saturday, when some 1,300 people set off from northern Honduras in what has been dubbed “March of the Migrant,” an organizer said. The migrants plan to seek refugee status in Mexico or pass through to the United States.

Reuters could not independently verify the number of participants, but images showed a group carrying backpacks and clogging roads near the border, some waving the Honduran flag.

The impoverished nations of Central America, from which thousands of migrants have fled in recent years, are under

mounting pressure from U.S. President Donald Trump's administration to do more to curb mass migration.

"We are seriously concerned about the caravan of migrants traveling north from Honduras, with false promises of entering the United States by those who seek to exploit their compatriots," the U.S. Embassy in Honduras said in a statement on Sunday evening.

Trump Says That Military Will Guard US Border
